Requirements to Host the Metropolis of Detroit Clergy-Laity Assembly and Philoptochos Conference

Introduction:

The following are the basic requirements to host the Metropolis of Detroit Clergy-Laity Assembly and Philoptochos Conference.

Note: If a Parish is interested in hosting the Clergy-Laity Assembly a more descriptive document is available by contacting the Metropolis Office.

A. Physical Requirements

- 1. Church Facility to seat at least 175 persons.
- 2. Banquet Room to accommodate 225 to 550 persons.
- 3. Meeting Rooms Minimum of four (two to accommodate 60 persons and two to accommodate 40 persons)
- 4. Meals Two meals a day for 150+ persons
- 5. Hotel Rooms 80 if hosted in the Metro-Detroit and 100 if hosted outside of the Detroit Area. Complimentary rooms are required and are to be coordinated with the Metropolis Council.
- 6. Exhibit Space for vendors.

B. Financial Requirements

- 1. Conference Cost target cost for each delegate should be in the \$275 to \$350 range. The host community assumes financial responsibility.
