METROPOLIS OF DETROIT PHILOPTOCHOS ELECTION PROCEDURES FOR THE METROPOLIS BOARD

1. Qualifications for election to the Metropolis Philoptochos Board to include the following

- a. A member wishing to be elected to the Metropolis Philoptochos Board must be present at the Metropolis Conference.
- b. If the member is unable to attend the Metropolis Conference, she must submit a letter in writing to the Board her reason for absence. This letter must be submitted 15 days prior to the Metropolis Conference. The Board will review the letter to determine the member's eligibility for election to the Board.
- c. The member must be in good standing in a parish and a member in good standing in a Philoptochos chapter for a minimum of two years.
- d. The member must have served a local chapter in an elected capacity for at least one full term

2. Term of Office

a. The term of office shall be two years

3. Election of Officers

The Officers of the Metropolis Board shall be elected by the members of the Metropolis Board following the Oath of Office administered by His Eminence Metropolitan Nicholas at the Metropolis Conference.

The members of the Metropolis Philoptochos Board should be willing to accept the responsibilities set forth in the bylaws of Philoptochos.

Article IV: Metropolis Philoptochos Board of Directors

1. Powers and Responsibilities

a) Authority to Act

The Metropolis Philoptochos Board of Directors ("the Metropolis Board") shall act as a liaison between the National Board and the parish chapters and shall, in consultation with the presiding hierarch, act on behalf of the Metropolis Philoptochos chapters between Metropolis Philoptochos Biennial Conferences.

Once again it is time for you to prepare and submit resolutions relating to legislative and non-legislative matters for consideration at the 2019 Metropolis Philoptochos Conference. In preparation for the conference, we request that you review the following provisions governing the content, style and procedure relating to resolutions.

- 1. All resolutions must be submitted in writing to the Metropolis Philoptochos Board no later than September 9th by mailing the resolutions to Metropolis of Detroit, 2560 Crooks Road, Troy, MI 48084 Attn: Philoptochos Resolutions. Resolutions submitted after September 9th may be brought to the Metropolis Philoptochos Conference by 5:00 pm on the day preceding the opening of the Conference. (Wednesday, Sept. 25)
- The resolutions may be submitted by a Philoptochos chapter or by an individual member. The proponent (or representative) must be able to speak on behalf of the resolution.
- 3. The resolution must be submitted in proper form, consistent with Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised.

Robert's Rule provides that "any resolution-and any long or complicated motion, whether cast as a resolution or not-should always be submitted in writing."


